I am wondering if you received my letter of Sept. 12th regarding my visit to Japan early next year, as I am going to lecture in Australia and New Zealand, and will perhaps be a month in each one of those places, and I could come on by Japan if you wish me to. The people of Australia and New Zealand are standing my expenses to their nations, and I am afraid the same arrangements would have to be made by the people in Japan if I come there. I have written to our co-workers throughout the rest of the world asking the same question. I must have a prompt reply if I am to include Japan in this trip, because by the first of next month I will have to apply for my passport and must know the various nations where I would visit.

Since you are always so prompt in answering, I sincerely believe that either you did not receive my letter or I had not received your reply. Last week a packet of mail including questions and answers booklet No. 5 was sent to you by surface mail. I hope it reaches you safely.

We have heard weather reports of the tragedies that visited Japan, and since we are all brothers my heart shares the sorrows of your people. In love, I send best wishes to each and every one, that the suffering may be quickly erased and restoration bring gladness into your lives.


