Dear Co-worker:

Since the Russians have landed a rocket on the moon we have received many inquiries as to why they were permitted to do so.

If those of you who have heard me lecture during the past year, especially on my recent world tour, will listen again to the tapes made at the lectures, you will note when the question was brought up, I replied that so long as the intention of a world's people was to learn we would be permitted, regardless of nationality or creed, to land on any body out there, not alone on the moon. This has now happened.

Why should we be pointing a finger at one nation when the world is in consideration? What difference does it make which nation gets there first so long as that nation shares the knowledge learned with the rest of the world, thereby focusing the attention of the people of the world on outer space? And the latest report made public is that Russia has now asked for a meeting of all the major nations to discuss the problems involved in the conquest of space.

As you know, the space people have not preferred any one spot of this world. They have shown themselves over every nation. If we are going to profit from their appearances and become as they are, we must do as they do. Our major trouble, as one can see, is not that we do not recognize man for man, but the segregating of men by labels--national or otherwise--makes strangers within one family (the Creator's Family) instead of all living as brothers and sisters. This is one lesson that the space people have tried to impress upon us.

True, should we attempt to go out there with warheads for the purpose of disturbing peace, they would not permit us to succeed. But so long as we go with the purpose of learning, they will help rather than stopping us. The recent successes of the Russians prove one thing beyond a shadow of any doubt, that the people who have claimed psychic (or telepathic contacts as some call them) have been false. For had their "messages" been coming from a true source, the Russian satellite would not be on the moon today. Each time something takes place toward enabling us to get out farther into outer space, it seems to prove the Brothers purpose and discredit prophecies coming from psychic sources.

Let us take up some such claims. While in London, I talked with George King, Desmond Leslie had invited us both to his apartment for the meeting and a tape recording was made of our conversation. During the talk Mr. King denied that his "contacts" had anything to do with the psychic or mediumism in any way. Yet not long ago he attended a convention in Los Angeles and it was reported that he would magnetize and hallow a mountain in southern California. Later the same report came from northern California where another convention was held.

But the truth is that if a mountain is not magnetic or holy by the Creator's handiwork, man's blessing cannot make it so.
